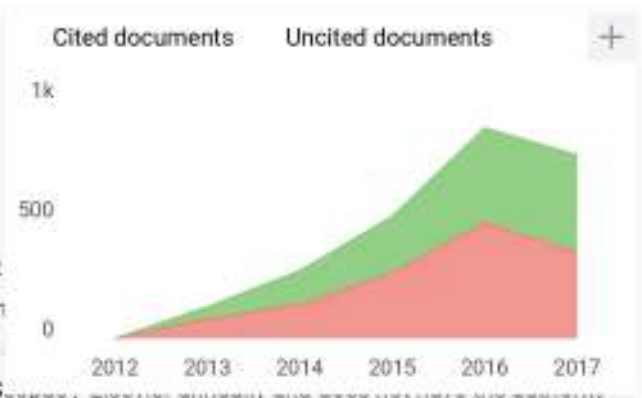
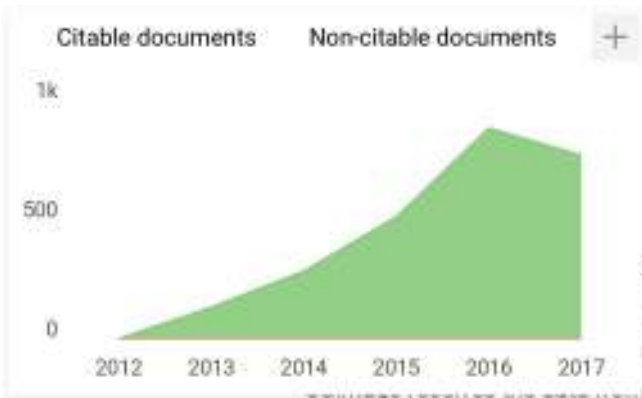


Citations per document

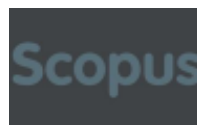
