Abstract (Calibri 12, 1 space)

Abstract should be a summary of your paper and included the keywords. It must be written in English, single space, Calibri 12, between 450-500 words in length and include the objectives of the study, methodology, results and discussion, conclusion and implication. Please avoid scientific or engineering symbols, acronyms and bullets.

Keywords (Calibri 12): containing words in order to enhance online accessibility to article (maximum 5 words)

I. Introduction (Calibri 12, 1.5 space)

The introduction should contain precise and concise background, along with literature review related to the topic of article. The objectives are written at the end of the introduction. The name of the organism, written under a common name or local name, must be followed by a latin name at first, eg *Nilaparvata lugens* (Hemiptera: Delphacidae), then may choose one of them. It is recommended to use standard citing applications for citing references, such as Mendeley or Zotero.

II. Methods (Calibri 12, 1.5 space)

The methods include all methods that be used to conduct the research or to collect the data. All chemicals or supporting equipment should be written followed by the specifications.

III. Results and Discussion (Calibri 12, 1.5 space)

Results and discussion could be written together or separately, and presented in sequence, from the main result to the support. **Formula and equation** should be noted that all easily confused characters and symbols, upper and lower case letters, as well as block and italicized lettering should be noticed to the proceedings editor. In this sample, the following equations are presented as illustration:

$$\int_0^{r_2} F(r, \varphi) \, dr \, d\varphi = [\sigma r_2 / (2\mu_0)] \tag{1}$$

where t = 0, ..., T, and b is a number greater than 1.

Tables, figure and picture are placed directly into the text appropriately. The tables should also be numbered like Table 1, 2, 3...etc and same as the figure. Figure captions should be centered below the figure; table captions should be centered above. Figure should be supplied in either vector art formats (Illustrator, EPS, WMF, FreeHand, CorelDraw, PowerPoint, Excel, etc.) or bitmap formats (Photoshop, TIFF, GIF, JPEG, etc.). Bitmap images should be of 300 dpi resolution at least. Pictures should be supplied electronic image file, original files of 300dpi or more and should be indicated the file name and an ordinal number of picture. The table is made in open form and the title of table is placed on it (1 space).




Figure 1. The sample of figure

The fullpaper should be typed in Microsoft Word file (*.doc/*docx). It is limited to 15 pages, including abstract, references, tables/charts/ pictures and keywords.

The discussion is to interpret the results and to relate them to existing knowledge in the field in as clear and brief a fashion as possible. Information given elsewhere in the paper should not be repeated in the discussion. Extensive reviews of the literature should be avoided.

Conclusion (Calibri 12, 1.5 spaces)

The conclusion should be written in one paragraph, briefly and clearly.

Acknowledgement (Calibri 12, 1.5 spaces)

The acknowledgement contains thanks to those who strongly contribute to the research that will be published. It is also written in one paragraph.

References

Each reference that be referred to and mentioned in the article (author, year) should be written in the references. The references should follow the style recommended by the American Psychological Associations (APA) Publication Manual (please visit http://www.apastyle.org/learn/quick-guide-on-references.aspx).
